It utilizes a rapid referral platform to efficiently refer individuals with opioid use disorder to community-based, high-quality treatment organizations.

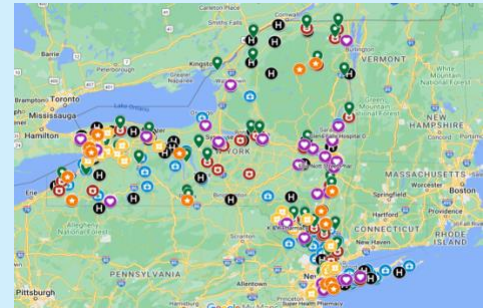

KEY COMPONENTS

Medication Voucher Program



Vouchers cover up to 14-days of a buprenorphine/naloxone prescription for uninsured individuals.

MATTERS participates with major pharmacies across NYS including various independently owned locations.

Transportation Voucher Program UBER Health

Individuals are now offered transportation to and from their first clinic appointment through a partnership with Uber Health.

Harm Reduction Services

MATTERS distributes free harm reduction supplies to individuals and organizations across NYS, including fentanyl test strips, xylazine test strips, and naloxone. MATTERS additionally deploys harm reduction vending machines to bring these supplies directly to the communities that need them.

Peer Referral

Individuals also have the option to be linked with a local peer service for support.

Person-Centered Approach

The MATTERS referral process is completed electronically in collaboration with the individual, allowing the person being referred to take ownership of their own referral. Individuals choose to seek treatment at any MATTERS participating treatment organization.
